participation they create an interactive architecture, in both small and large-scale projects, through critical and challenging speculation. NaJa & deOstos have run workshops and lectured widely in countries like Brazil, Russia, Korea, USA, Turkey and throughout Europe. Since 2012 they are involved in the development of the European Design Innovation Policy.



Ricardo de Ostos was appointed curator of the Brazilian Pavilion for the London Festival of Architecture in 2008 and 2010.
